- Several. Number one: WHY DO WE HAVE TO READ WORKS IN MIDDLE ENGLISH!? Everything else we read is already a translation anyway, why can we not simply use a version in modern English? All it does is make otherwise interesting material into something both extremely unpleasant and immensely time-consuming to get through, while reducing our reading-comprehension to almost nil! Number two: If you're not going to stick to the syllabus, at least tell us what the next assignment is going to be, or if there even is going to be an assignment, more than one class (two days mon-wens) in advance. It makes planning ahead much harder. Number three: if you are going to disregard number two and spring readings on us with little time to plan, at least make the length and difficulty of the readings somewhat consistent. The length and difficulty of 'for next class' readings varied from trivial to requiring multiple days to completely at random. Number four: Okay, this only happened once, but please try to make it clear whether something is a writing assignment due next class, or a major project due in a month. I had a panic attack because I wasn't going to be able to complete a giant essay I knew nothing about in time for the next class when I assumed it was due.
- Perhaps covering one whole longer text, maybe all of Margery Kempe or the Canterbury Tales.
- sometimes we would have really long readings in middle english due on wednesday and there wouldn't be enough time to prepare for them
- I wasn't very interested in some of the more creative writing assignments and I think it would've been better to stick to analysis.
